What is Salvation?

Salvation is God's gift of restoration—rescuing humanity from separation, broken fellowship with Him, and the consequences of sin that entered the world through Adam's fall in the Garden of Eden.

When you place your faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you receive complete redemption through His one perfect sacrifice on the cross. Your sins are fully forgiven, you are clothed in God's own righteousness, and you are welcomed into His presence with confidence.

God becomes your Heavenly Father, and you are restored to a living relationship filled with grace, hope, and eternal life

Why do I need Salvation?

The Bible says that the result of sin is death (Romans 6:23). This means that on our own, we cannot escape the punishment for sin. But God is loving and good (1 John 4:8, 16). Because He loves us, He made a way for us to be saved and have eternal life (John 3:16).

God sent His Son, **Jesus Christ**, to take our place. Jesus died on the cross for our sins. He carried the punishment we deserved and gave His life for us. Jesus is perfect and without sin (Hebrews 4:15), so He alone could pay the full price for our sins.

When we believe in Jesus and what He did for us, we are forgiven and saved. We can come close to God as our Father (Hebrews 4:16) and receive a new life filled with hope and peace (John 10:10).

There is no other way to be saved except through Jesus (Acts 4:12). When we accept Him, we receive eternal life and a new relationship with God.

How DO I GET SAVED?

Salvation is a free gift from God. It comes by believing in **Jesus Christ** and Him alone. The Bible says that Jesus is the only way to God and eternal life (John 14:6). It also shows us how to be saved: believe in your heart that Jesus died for your sins and rose again, and confess Him as your Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9–11). If you want to receive Jesus into your life, you can pray this prayer:

Salvation Prayer

“Heavenly Father, thank You for loving me. Thank You for sending Jesus Christ to die on the cross for my sins. I believe His blood washes me clean. I believe You raised Him from the dead and He is alive today. Thank You that my sins are forgiven. I receive Your grace and forgiveness. I declare that Jesus is my Lord and Savior. In Jesus' name, Amen.
